The Carroll County Ag Center is a large facility with several flea-market style buildings. There is a large gravel parking lot and plenty of grassy space for dogs to potty. There is no shade available in the parking area. The walk from the parking area to the test building is moderate in distance and may require you to walk on uneven ground or uphill. Both the parking lot and the test building are ADA accessible.

#### Entry method

- 🐾 First received by USPS mail (overnight entries must be checked “signature waived” to be valid)
- 🐾 Entries arriving before the opening date will not be valid
- 🐾 Entry opens Wednesday, January 15, 2020
- 🐾 Entry closes Friday, February 28 at 5:00pm (or when entry limit is met)
- 🐾 If less than 30 entries are received, the event will be cancelled and refunds issued

***Entries are LIMITED to 100 tests***

## Test Site Information

The buildings at the test site are flea-market style buildings with metal walls, concrete floors, high ceilings and heat. There is a large gravel parking lot and plenty of grassy space for dogs to potty. There is no shade available in the parking area so plan to bring items for your dog's comfort. There is a moderate walk from the parking area to the test building which may require you to negotiate gravel, pavement, uneven terrain and/or stairs. Both the parking lot and the test building are ADA accessible. Dogs must be crated in your vehicle when not testing. All dogs must be on a 6' leash at all times when not testing. Flexi-leashes are permitted during the ORT itself but at NO other time on the premises. Restrooms will be available during testing.

## Entry Requirements

## Trial Eligibility and ORTs

An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.

## Entry Fee and Second Dog Policy

- 🐾 \$30 per odor/per dog (if the handler wishes to run a second dog on the same odor the fee is \$35.00)
- 🐾 Bitches in season must wear britches and will run last

## Closing Date

Friday, February 28 at 5:00pm (or when entry limit is met)

## Refund Policy (Please Read Carefully)

- 🐾 Cancellations received **on or before Friday, February 28 at 5pm** will receive a full refund less a \$10 processing fee.
- 🐾 Cancellations received **after Friday, February 28 at 5pm** will be refunded at the discretion of the host depending on whether your space can be filled.
- 🐾 NO refunds in the event of absence, disqualification or excusal by NACSW™ official or judge.
- 🐾 A \$35 fee will be charged for checks without sufficient funds. Non-entry will result unless the entry fee plus \$35 NSF fee are paid by money order or cashier's check within 7 days of notification.



### **Videography/Photography Policy**

ORT participants are allowed to have a friend or family member video/photograph their test. ORT participants are not allowed to video/photograph one another. ORT hosts are not obligated to provide videographers/photographers for the test.

### **Results**

During the odor re-sets, the official results sheet will be brought out to the parking area for testers to photo or review. We recommend you verify your results on the official results sheet and let your host or judge know if you have any questions regarding your results.

#### **From the North:**

(Directions given from Hanover, PA to the Ag Center)

Take Rt. 94 South (becomes MD Rt. 30 at the state line). Follow 30 to Manchester and turn right on Rt. 27. Follow Rt. 27 to Rt. 140 East (in Westminster). Turn left onto the ramp to 140 East and travel to the first traffic light. Turn right onto Center Street. Take Center Street through two traffic lights to Gist Road. Turn right on Gist Road and follow signs to new entrance. Turn right onto Ag Center drive.

#### **From the South:**

Take Interstate 270 North to Rt. 27. Follow Rt. 27 to Kate Wagner Road. (Kate Wagner Road intersects Rt. 27 before you reach the city of Westminster) Make a right onto Kate Wagner Road (which intersects Rt. 27 at a traffic light) and follow approximately 1.2 miles. Turn left onto Gist Road. Continue on Gist Road until you reach Smith Ave at stop sign. Continue on Gist Road about 1/2 block and make left at Ag Center entrance.

#### **From the East:**

From Baltimore Beltway 695, take Interstate 795 north toward Westminster. Follow the signs onto MD 140 and take 140 into Westminster. Turn left onto Center Street. Take Center Street through two traffic lights to Gist Road. Turn right on Gist Road and follow signs. Turn right onto Ag Center drive.

#### **From the West:**

Take I-70 East to the Mt. Airy/Route 27 Exit. Head North on Rt. 27 toward Westminster for approximately 15 miles. Make a right onto Kate Wagner Road (which intersects Rt. 27 at a traffic light) and follow approximately 1.2 miles. Turn left onto Gist Road. Continue on Gist Road until you reach Smith Ave at stop sign. Continue on Gist Road about 1/2 block and make left at Ag Center entrance.

## TEST Information - Notice to Exhibitors

### TEST SITE HOURS

8am – 4pm (or until all tests are completed).

### CHECK-IN/HANDLER BRIEFING

Details regarding check-in time and briefing will be sent approximately 1 week before the ORT.

**An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.**

**NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEARCH AREA** during the ORT except NACSW™ officials, adults accompanying a minor, CNWI-in-training, or immediate family members/friends of the dog/handler team currently being tested.

### ENTRIES

- 🐾 Telephone, fax, unsigned entries, and entries received without fees cannot be accepted.
- 🐾 RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$35 fee will be charged for checks without sufficient funds. Non-entry will result unless the entry fee plus \$35 NSF fee are paid by money order or cashier's check within 7 days of notification.
- 🐾 ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON THE ATTACHED ENTRY FORM.
- 🐾 NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- 🐾 OWNERS are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms.
- 🐾 EXPRESS MAIL entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without signature.

**DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for being ready when it is time to be tested. Be prepared to keep your dog in your car when not being tested or on leash at all times.

There is no inside crating available at the test site.

### FEMALES IN SEASON

Contact your host as soon as possible (a minimum of 1 day before the test) if this is a possibility.

**DOGS PARTICIPATING** in ORT must be at least six months of age and must appear to be healthy on trial day and should be current on all vaccination as required by law.

**CONFIRMATION** of entry acceptance will be made electronically when entries are processed for those handlers that provide an email address. If you require a confirmation via USPS, you must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry.
